



If you're having a spring clean and are going to visit one of the 3 MK tips, here's some safety rules you need to know:

- No pedestrian access - vehicles only
- Stick to the designated pathways and crossings
- Watch for other tip users when carrying waste to the collection areas
- Bend knees before lifting heavy objects
- Children and pets must remain inside vehicles
- Wear appropriate clothing for protections e.g. no shoes without a closed toe,
- No flip flops, wear trousers not shorts and use good safety gloves.
- If you have chemicals please speak to a member of staff.
- No smoking or using mobile phones
- No hot ashes to be disposed of at any tip
- Do not climb into the skips or over walls

This site does not accept asbestos

Newport Road, New Bradwell MK13 0AH

This large site accepts all waste on the list as well as asbestos

Opening Times

All 3 sites are open 7 days a week from:

8am to 8pm from 1st April to 30th September

8am to 5pm from 1st October to 31st March

Closed Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day.

Sites will close at 1pm on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.

All the tips are busy at the weekends so if you can, go during the week to avoid queues.
